Annette Dittert is a foreign correspondent and passionate filmmaker for ARD, German TV. She became known to a wide audience as studio manager and correspondent in Warsaw, later in New York and London.

Since then, Annette Dittert has lived on the Regents Canal, on her houseboat Emilia. Annette Dittert has been awarded two Grimme Prizes for her films. In 2004, she received the "Hanns Joachim Friedrichs Prize" for her reporting on Poland.
